AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPALITY OF GLORIA CULTURE AND THE ARTS COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ITS OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, Section 447(a) (5) (xvi), 458 (a) (5) xvi, and 468 (a) (4) (viii) of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160, otherwise known as the " Local Government Code of 1991" or LGC, provided as part of the powers, duties, and functions of the Sangguniang Bayan, Sangguniang Panglungsod and Sangguniang Panlalawigan respectively the approval of the ordinances that ensure the establishments of a local council whose purpose is the promotion of culture and arts, coordinate with government agencies and non-government and appropriate funds for the support and development of said council, subject to availability thereof;

WHEREAS, consistent with the above-stated purpose is the protection, preservation and promotion of cultural heritage and the ethnicity of local communities. In line with this, the DILG-OSEC special provisions under Republic Act. No. 10924 or the General Appropriations Act of 2017 mandated DILG to ensure the establishment of the local council. To strengthen the LGU as a cultural institution, its obligations prescribed in the National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009 are hereby rationalized as one of the functions of the Local Culture and Arts Council;

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 2017-133 issued by the Department of the Interior and Local Government enjoined all provinces, cities and municipalities to legislate for the establishment of Local Culture and the Arts Council, implement related project and/or strengthen existing ones thereafter

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint motion of Hon. Nick Orlando M. Jamilla and Hon. Lauro L. De Belen, duly seconded by all Sangguniang Bayan Members present during the session,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF GLORIA, ORIENTAL MINDORO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be known as the Municipality of Gloria Culture and the Arts Council Ordinance of 2019.

SECTION 2. Declaration of Principles. – The following principles, as spelled out in Republic Act No. 7356 creating the National Commission for Culture and the Arts are hereby adopted by this ordinance:

a.) CULTURE AS A HUMAN RIGHT. Culture is a manifestation of the freedom of belief and of expression and is a human right to be accorded due respect and allowed to flourish.


b.) NATIONAL IDENTITY. Culture reflects and shapes values, beliefs, aspirations, thereby defining a people’s national identity. A Filipino national culture that mirrors and shapes Philippine economic, social and political life shall be evolved, promoted and conserved.


c.) CULTURE OF THE PEOPLE. The Filipino national culture shall be:


- **INDEPENDENT**, free of political and economic structures which inhibit cultural sovereignty;
- **EQUITABLE**, effectively creating and distributing cultural opportunities and correcting the imbalance that has long prejudiced the poor and other marginalized sectors who have the least opportunities for cultural development and educational growth;
- **DYNAMIC**, continuously developing in pace with scientific, technological, social, economic and political changes both in national and international levels;
- **PROGRESSIVE**, developing the vast potential of all Filipinos as responsible change agents of society; and
- **HUMANISTIC**, ensuring the freedom and creativity of the human spirit.

d.) CULTURE BY THE PEOPLE. The Filipino national culture shall be evolved and developed by the people themselves in a climate of freedom and responsibility.

e.) CULTURE FOR THE PEOPLE. The creation of artistic and cultural products shall be promoted and disseminated to the greatest number of the people. The level of consciousness of the people about cultural values in order to strengthen culture and to instill nationhood and cultural unity shall be raised formally through the educational system and informally through extra-scholastic means, including the use of traditional as well as the modern media of communication.

f.) PRESERVATION OF THE FILIPINO HERITAGE. It is the duty of every citizen to preserve and conserve the Filipino historical and cultural heritage and resources. The retrieval and conservation of artifacts of Filipino culture and history shall be vigorously pursued.”

SECTION 3. Creation of the Council. – Envisioned to be the local counterpart of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, the Municipality of Gloria Culture and the Arts Council is hereby created to formulate policies for the development of culture and the arts at the municipal level; implement these policies in coordination with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts as well as affiliated cultural entities both from the private and public sectors; “ encourage artistic creation within a climate of artistic freedom; develop and promote the Filipino national culture and arts; and preserve Filipino cultural heritage.” The council shall be under the Office of the Municipal Mayor and shall render annual accomplishment report to the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 4. Composition. – The Municipality of Gloria Culture and the Arts Council shall be composed of the following:



SECTION 5. Term of Office. – The Sangguniang Bayan members shall serve up to the end of their current term as Sanggunian Bayan Members. Private sector representatives shall be co-terminus with that of the appointing Authority.


SECTION 6. Mandate. – The Council is hereby mandated to conceptualize, craft and implement plans, policies, programs and projects in conformity with the principles spelled out in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 7. Powers and Functions. – In order to pursue its mandate, the Council shall have the following powers and functions:

- Prepare an annual plan on culture. Arts, and cultural heritage consonant with the Philippine Development Plan for Culture and Arts, to be integrated in the local development plan and considered in the annual appropriation ordinances;

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- b. Formulate programs and recommendations to develop and sustain local culture and artistic talents, cultural industries, traditional and contemporary arts and crafts, and their processes;
- c. Coordinate with the appropriate affiliated cultural agencies of the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) for the conservation and monitoring of national cultural properties found in the LGU;
- d. Conduct cultural events such as cultural festivals, competition, lectures, seminars and symposia;
- e. Identify such other programs and activities for the promotion of local cultural heritage and arts;
- f. Ensure the protection, preservation and conservation of the local cultural and historical heritage;
- g. Declare and maintain Local Heritage Zones;
- h. Establish a Local Registry of Cultural Property;
- i. Acknowledge the importance of traditional folk artist as singular conduit between skills of the past and the future;
- j. Revitalize a community's artistic tradition thereby protecting a valuable fact of Philippine culture;
- k. Provide mechanisms for identification and assistance for qualified traditional folk artist to transfer their skills to the community;
- l. Create opportunities for popularizing their works locally
- m. Craft the implementing rules and regulations of this ordinance;
- n. Formulate the annual budget of the Council and submit the same to the Municipal Mayor for inclusion in the annual budget; and
- o. Perform other functions which may be necessary for the preservation/conservation of national cultural heritage/properties.

SECTION 8. Operational Budget. – During its first year of operation, the Council shall draw its budget from the account of the Municipal Tourism Office and, in the succeeding year(s), a separate appropriation account in favor of the Council shall be included in the annual budget.

SECTION 9. Secretariat. – The Office of the Municipal Administrator shall act as secretariat of the Municipality of Gloria Culture and the Arts Council.


SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. – All resolutions, ordinances, memoranda and other issuances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the completion of its full publication in local newspapers of general circulation of the municipality.






