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MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 09

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING COCKFIGHTING, THE ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF COCKPITS AND THE BREEDING OF GAMECOCKS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GLORIA, ORIENTAL MINDORO.

WHEREAS, cockfighting has been and still is a popular, traditional and customary form of recreation and entertainment among Filipinos during legal holidays, local fiestas, agricultural, commercial and industrial fairs, carnivals and expositions;

WHEREAS, Section 447 of the Local Government Code of 1991 delegates the power to the Sangguniang Bayan, as legislative body of the municipality to enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, authorize and license the establishment, operation, and maintenance of cockpits, and regulate cockfighting and commercial breeding of gamecocks;

WHEREAS, the provision of PD 499, otherwise known as the Cockfighting Law of 1974, and such other pertinent laws shall apply to all matters regarding the operation of cockpit and the holding of cockfights in the Municipality.

WHEREAS, in order to regulate cockfighting in the municipality, the establishment, maintenance and operation of cockpits and the breeding of gamecocks, the Sangguniang Bayan enacts this Ordinance to serve as an effective tool in maintaining the balance between a recreational activity and the moral standing of the municipality consistent with enhancing local productivity and self-reliance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE ENACTED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF GLORIA IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, BY VIRTUE OF POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, THAT:

Section 1. Short Title – This Ordinance shall be known as the “Cockfighting Ordinance of 2019” of the Municipality of Gloria.

Section 2. Purpose – The purpose of this Ordinance is to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality, to ensure and support the preservation and enrichment of culture while enhancing generation of local income and productivity;

Section 3. Coverage – This Ordinance shall govern the issuance of franchise and license on the establishment, operation and maintenance of cockpits and ownership thereof. It also provides for the regulation of cockfighting and commercial breeding of gamecock in the territorial jurisdiction of Gloria. It shall apply to all persons, whether natural or juridical, whether residents or not, and in all places within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Gloria, Province of Oriental Mindoro.

Section 4. Definition of Terms – As used in this Ordinance, the terms below shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section. Any words of terms not defined shall be given their plain and customary meanings, unless the context requires otherwise, and shall be interpreted in a manner consistent with the purpose and force of this Ordinance:

- (a) Cockfighting (Sabong) – means the commonly known game “cockfighting” and shall include derby, pintakasi, tupada, or its equivalent terms in different Philippines dialects
- (b) Cockpit (Sabungan) – means the commonly known game arena provided with one or more gates or doors or points of entrance and exit, and duly licensed for the purpose of holding cockfighting, derby, pintakasi, tupada or fighting of two (2) gamecocks
- (c) Cockfight (Soltada) – refers to the actual fight or physical combat of two (2) pitted or every matched gamecocks where bets on either side are laid
- (d) International Derby – means a cockfight promotion with foreign participants or entries
- (e) National Derby – means a cockfight promotion with nationwide participants or entries
- (f) Regional Derby – means a cockfight with regional participants or entries
- (g) Regular Cockfight – means a cockfight held on Sundays and legal holidays as allowed in this Ordinance
- (h) Special Cockpit – means a cockfight held on days other than Sundays and legal holidays, or other days not included as regular cockfight
- (i) Special Permit - means a permit secured from the Sangguniang Bayan to hold cockfighting on day other than Sundays or legal holidays provided therein
- (j) Pit Manager – refers to a person who professionally, regularly and habitually manages a cockfight, who may or not be the owner of the cockpit himself
- (k) Referee (Sentenciador) - means a person who matches and oversees the progress of the cockfight and decides its result by announcing the winner or declaring a draw or non-contest game
- (l) Bet Manager (Kasador) – refers to a person who calls and takes care of bets from owner of both gamecocks and those of other bettors before he orders a commencement of the cockfight and thereafter distribute winning bets to the winners after deducting a certain commission
- (m) Bettor – refers to a person who participates in cockfighting and with the use of money or other things of value, bets with other bettors or through other bet takers and wins or loses his bets depending upon the result of the cockfight as announced by the referee or either legs
- (n) Gaffer (Mananari) – refers to a person knowledgeable in the techniques of arming fighting cocks with gaffs on either legs
- (o) Handler (Sultador) – refers to a person who permanently takes physical custody and control inside the arena or pitted game cock and who actually releases the fighting cocks for actual fight and combat in a cockpit
- (p) Promoter – refers to a person duly licensed by the municipal government who is engaged in the promotion, holding and the celebration of specially programmed and arranged cockfighting like local and international derbies or competitors, pintakasi and ordinary cockfights
- (q) Gamecock – refers to domesticated fowl, whether imported or local in origin specially bred and trained for the purpose of cockfighting

- (r) Breeder – refers to a person engaged in game fowl breeding and propagation for personal and/or commercial purposes for eventual use in cockfighting
- (s) Cocker (Aficionado) – refers to a person who participates and bets in cockfighting
- (t) Zoning Law or Ordinance – means either or both national or municipal legislation which logically arranges, prescribes, define and apportions a given political subdivision into specified land uses as present and future projection of needs in accordance with law o ordinances
- (u) Franchise – refers to a right or privilege granted by the municipal government to any person or corporation to engage in a specialized activity. This term is synonymous to license as used in this Ordinance.
- (v) Commercial breeding or gamecocks – means any personal or juridical person or corporation engaged in a duly registered business or breeding and selling gamecocks with an annual sale of more than five (5) fighting cocks

Section 5. Ownership Operation and Management of Cockpits

The following persons or entities may own, operate or manage cockpit:

- (a) Filipino citizens not otherwise prohibited by law;
- (b) Cooperative or corporation, the capitalization of which is one hundred percent (100%) Filipino-owned, formed, organized, or licensed for such purposes.

Section 6. Establishment of Cockpits - "As provided in Section 1 of PD 1310 dated March 6, 1978, only one cockpit shall be allowed in each city or municipality: Provided, however, that in cities and municipalities with a population of more than one hundred thousand, two cockpits may be established, maintained and operated in the Poblacion and one in each city or town district.

Section 7. Site, Location and Security of Cockpits


- (a) No cockpits shall be constructed, established, maintained and/or operated within a radius of two hundred(200) linear meters from any existing residential or commercial areas, hospitals, school buildings, churches or other public buildings;
- (b) No two (2) cockpit licenses or franchises may be issued or granted to one and the same person;
- (c) No two (2) cockpits may be constructed and operated within a distance of less than one (1) kilometre from each other and within the same political district of the municipality;
- (d) No cockpit may be constructed in any barangay without first securing a clearance or permit from the barangay concerned;
- (e) All cockpit arenas shall provide spacious parking area for vehicles of its customers so as not to affect the flow of traffic and avoid traffic accidents;
- (f) All cockpit owners, operators or licensees shall employ the services of trained security guards to ensure peace, order and safety among all participants and stakeholders of cockfighting.


Section 8. Term of Franchise


The license/franchise of cockpits issued shall be valid for a term of five (5) years from date of issuance, renewable by the authority of the Sangguniang Bayan for the same period after compliance with all the conditions for renewal as provided for herein;

Section 9. Requirements for Granting of Franchise

1. New Franchise – every application for a new franchise to operate and maintain a cockpit shall be filed with the Sangguniang Bayan of Gloria, accompanied with the following documents:
 - (a) Location and vicinity plan of the cockpit including the parking area;
 - (b) Approved cockpit building plan/design by the Municipal Engineer, duly certified as to compliance that the cockpit building and facilities are constructed in accordance to provisions of the National Building Code of the Philippines;

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- (c) Approved Locational Clearance by the Deputized Zoning Administrator certifying that the area/location of cockpit conforms to the Zoning Ordinance of Gloria;
 - (d) Certification by the Deputized Zoning Administrator that there are no existing residential or commercial area, hospitals, school buildings, churches or other linear meters from the cockpit buildings;
 - (e) Official receipts showing payments of municipal taxes, fees and other levies prescribed by the Revenue Code of Gloria and other impositions by the national agencies and other departments concerned;
 - (f) Clearance from the punong barangay concerned allowing construction of said cockpit in his/her barangay;
2. Renewal of Franchise – Every application for the renewal of a franchise shall be submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan not later than January 20 of every year. It shall be accompanied with the following documents:
- (a) Official receipts showing payment of municipal taxes, fees and other levies as prescribed by Revenue Code of Gloria and other ordinances;
 - (b) Certification by the Municipal Engineer that the building housing the cockpit is free from any material, structural or other defects, or fire hazards and that the building is fit for cockfighting purposes;
 - (c) Clearance from the punong barangay where the cockpit is situated;
 - (d) Mayor's permit in the preceding year;
 - (e) Health Certification issued by Municipal Health Office in the preceding year.

Cockpit officials/employees who are not wearing the prescribed uniform shall not be allowed to participate/take part of any cockfighting activity. The owner/licensee/franchisee, or operator/manager of the cockpit shall provide for these uniforms, and they are not allowed to employ any gaffer, referee, bet taker (Ilamador) promoter, bet manager and pit manager who is not registered or has no Mayor's Permit;

Section 10. Time and Place of Holding Cockfight

Cockfights may be held only in licensed cockpits during Sundays and legal holidays, not otherwise prohibited in this Ordinance; Provided that, no cockfighting shall be held during other days of the week and the following legal holidays:

- (a) Maundy Thursday
- (b) Good Friday
- (c) Philippine Independence Day (June 12)
- (d) All Saint's Day (November 1)
- (e) National Heroes day (November 30)
- (f) Election Day, Plebiscite of Referendum Day
- (g) Registration Day such Referendum Day or Plebiscite Day
- (h) Rizal Day (December 30)

Section 11. When to allow Special Cockfighting

Special cockfighting shall only be allowed on the following occasions upon authority by the Sangguniang Bayan Provided that, no cockfighting whether regular or special hack fights including derby shall be allowed in one cockpit oftener than three (3) times a week.

- (a) On occasion of the town fiesta (February 15) for not more than three consecutive days and not more than once a year
- (b) Three (3) consecutive days during a provincial, municipal, agricultural, commercial or industrial fair, carnival or exposition for a similar period of time;
- (c) For entertainment of foreign dignitaries, tourists or returning Filipinos commonly known as Balikbayans; Provided that, only one (1) permit may be issued for the same purpose in calendar year by the Sangguniang Bayan for a period not exceeding three (3) consecutive days;

- (d) For the support of local fund-raising campaign for charitable purposes as may be authorized by the Municipal Mayor in consultation with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office;
- (e) For fund-raising for the purpose of barangay fiesta celebration and other purposes.

Section 12. Resolution/Permit Required for Special Cockfights

No special cockfight including national or regional cockfighting derby shall be allowed unless authorized through a resolution of the Sangguniang Bayan and after payment of the corresponding special permit fee.

Application for such special cockfight shall be filed in the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan, at least ten (10) days before the event. Such application letter must be duly signed by the owner, operator or licensee of the cockpit where such special cockfight is to be held, and supported by the recommendation or letter endorsement by the Municipal Mayor to the Sangguniang Bayan to authorize the holding of such special cockfight. The Sangguniang Bayan may pass a resolution to authorize the holding of such special cockfight quarterly provided after payment of the corresponding special permit fee for the quarter.

Section 13. Prohibited Acts

- (1) No person shall accept any bet without the corresponding money at his disposal to respond to the bet in case he loses;
- (2) No person shall talk to, interfere with or in any way obstruct the act of the handler (sultador) while the latter is releasing his fighting cock;
- (3) No person shall talk to, interfere with or in any way hamper the referee while the latter is overseeing the cockfight in progress or when he is in the act of rendering his decision in consummated cockfighting match;
- (4) No person shall sell liquor inside the cockpit;
- (5) No person under the influence of liquor shall be allowed to enter the cockpit premises;
- (6) No person except the referee, handlers and such other authorized officials not to exceed five (5) persons shall be allowed inside the cockpit arena while a cockfighting is in progress;
- (7) No person shall be allowed to participate or deal with other gambling game/activities of whatever nature during an authorized cockfight:
 - (a) Inside the cockpit or within its premises;
 - (b) Outside the cockpit at a distance of fifty (50) linear meters from the cockpit arena or building.
- (8) No person shall be allowed to carry firearms, either for personal or official use/reason, unless authorized by law;
- (9) No operator, owner or licensee of a cockpit shall employ or allow to participate in a cockfighting activity any gaffer, referee, bet taker, promoter, bet manager or pit manager who has not secured a registration certificate;
- (10) Smoking shall be strictly prohibited within the cockpit premises; Provided that, it shall only be allowed within the designated smoking area in an open space outside the cockpit building;
- (11) No person less than eighteen (18) years of age (minor) shall be allowed to enter the premises of the cockpit whether or not, to bet or to participate in any way in the cockfighting activity;

The owner, operator, licensee, grantee or franchisee and/or the violator/s shall be held liable for any violation after due court proceedings, with corresponding penalties of fine or imprisonment as provided in Section 22 of this Ordinance.

Section 14. Commercial Breeding of Gamecocks or Fighting Cocks

No person shall be allowed to breed fighting cocks for commercial or business purposes without first registering with the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The latter shall furnish the Office of the Municipal Agriculturist, a list of duly registered commercial gamecock breeders.

Any duly registered breeder who sells more than five (5) gamecocks annually shall be considered a commercial breeder.

Section 15. Filing of Complaints and Protests

All complaints related to the establishment, operator and maintenance of cockpits or the conduct of cockfighting and violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be filed with the proper courts within fifteen (15) days from the incidence of such violation. The complaint or protest must be verified complaint. This is without prejudice to the action to be taken by the Sangguniang Bayan if the offense or violation is a ground for revocation or cancellation of license/franchise.

Section 16. Power of Authority to Grant and/or Revoke License/Franchise

As provided in Section 48 of the Local Government Code of 1991, authority is hereby vested in Sangguniang Bayan of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro, to grant or issue a license/franchise to establish, maintain and operate a cockpit in the Municipality of Gloria to any qualified person, cooperative or corporation in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance. As such, the power to approve a license or franchise includes by implication, the power to revoke it.

Section 17. Grounds for Cancellation, Revocation or Withdrawal of Franchise

- (a) Failure to operate within a period of one (1) year from the granting of franchise;
- (b) Cockpit has been operated contrary to law, or that it has been operated/used for other forms of illegal gambling or other illegal activities;
- (c) Failure to pay all taxes, fees and charges due to the Municipal Government of Gloria, and secure a Mayor's Permit within the period prescribed in this Ordinance;
- (d) Failure by the franchisee, grantee or licensee to comply with all the requirements and conditions provided for in this Ordinance.

Section 18. Fees to be Paid

There shall be collected an annual fees from cockpit operators/owners/licensees as follows:

- A. On cockpit operators/owners/licensees:
 - a. Application/filing fee P200.00
 - b. Annual cockpit permit fee.....P1,400.00
- B. Permit Fee for Cockfighting. There shall be collected from the operator/promoter of cockfight the following fees for cockfighting such as:
 - (a) Franchise fee to operate cockpit P 5,000.00
 - (b) Franchise fee to renewal of cockpit..... P 10,000.00
 - (c) Registration Fee for cockpit personnel:
 - c1. PromoterP 700.00/year
 - c2. Pit ManagerP 500.00/year
 - c3. RefereeP 500.00/year
 - c4. Bet Manager P300.00/year
 - c5. Bet Taker.....P 300.00/year
 - c6. Gaffer..... P 300.00/year
 - (d) Permit Fee (Promoter):
 - d1. International Derby P 7,500.00/derby
 - d2. National DerbyP 5,000.00/derby
 - d3. Regional DerbyP 4,000.00/derby
 - (e) Permit Fee to hold cockfight:
 - e1. Special cockfighting (pintakasi)..... P2,500.00/day

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
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

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

- (g) Mayor's Permit Fee for commercial breeding of gamecocks:
 - g1. For the first 5 heads P 50.00
 - g2. Every succeeding head P10.00

Section 19. Time and Manner of Payment.

1. The application or filing fee is payable to the Municipal Treasurer upon application for a permit or license to operate and maintain cockpit. The cockpit registration and registration of all personnel are also payable upon application for a permit and within the first twenty (20) days of January for each year in case for renewal thereof.
2. Permit fee for International Derby, National Derby, Regional Derby and permit fee to hold cockfight shall be paid to Municipal Treasurer's Office before the cockfight.
3. Payment for sultada fee shall be paid per cockfight before the sultada. This will be collected by the authorized personnel of the MTO during the cockfights. There shall be one (1) receipt per cockfight.
4. Mayor's Permit Fee for commercial breeding of gamecocks shall be paid in the Office of the Municipal Treasurer within the first twenty (20) days of January.

Section 20. Book/s of Accounts and Record Keeping

All duly authorized cockpits shall be required to keep a Book or Books of Accounts and Financial Records pertaining to the operation of the cockpit. These records shall be kept open for inspection and examination of the Office of the Municipal Treasurer.

Section 21. Financial Statement of Proceeds from Cockfight for Charitable Purposes

For fund raising cockfight for charitable or humanitarian purpose, the owner operator or licensee shall report on a daily basis, the receipts from gate or entrance and ringside tickets and the total commission (plazada) for the day.

After the cockfighting event for charitable purpose, the cockpit, owner, operator or licensee shall turnover to the authorized representative of the recipient charitable institution or organization, the share of the proceeds as per agreement or contract. In the absence of such agreement or contract, the sharing of proceeds shall be sixty percent (60%) to the operator (40%) to the recipient charitable institution/organization.

The owner, operator or licensee of the cockpit shall, within fifteen (15) days after the cockfighting event, submit to the Office of the Municipal Mayor a copy of the daily financial report and the financial summary of the cockfight held for fund-raising activity or charitable or humanitarian purpose.

Section 22. Penal Provisions

Violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, after due process, subject the owner, operator, licensee, grantee or franchisee and/or the violator/s to a penalty:

(1) For Section 13 (1), (2) & (3)

First Offense P 500.00
Second Offense P 1,000.00
Third Offense P 2,500.00 or imprisonment of no less than six (6) months, or both, at the discretion of the Court, without prejudice to the penalties imposed for violation of existing laws.

(2) For Section 13 (4) (Selling of Liquor)

First Offense P 500.00 and one week suspension of permit
Second Offense P 1,000.00 and two weeks suspension of permit
Third Offense P 2,500.00 and cancelation of permit.

(3) For Section 13 (5) (When the operator allowed the person entering the cockpit under the influence of liquor)

First Offense P 500.00 and one week suspension of permit
Second Offense P 1,000.00 and two weeks suspension of permit
Third Offense P 2,500.00 and cancelation of permit

(4) For Section 13 (6), (7) & (8)

First Offense P 2,000.00
Second Offense P 2,500.00
Third Offense P 2,500.00 with imprisonment of not less than six (6) months at the discretion of the Court, without prejudice to the penalties imposed for violation of existing national laws.

(5) For Section 13 (8) (Carrying of Firearms)

First Offense P 1,000.00
Second Offense P 1,500.00
Third Offense P 2,500.00 or imprisonment of not less the six (6) months, or both, at the discretion of the Court, without prejudice to the penalties imposed for violation of existing national laws.

(6) For Section 13 (9) (Employment of Unregistered Personnel)

First Offense P 200.00 and one week suspension of permit
Second Offense P 500.00 and two weeks suspension of permit
Third Offense P1,000.00 or imprisonment for a period not less than five (5) days but not exceeding ten (10) days, or both at the discretion of the Court, without prejudice to the penalties imposed for violation of existing national laws.

(8) For Section 13 (11) (Prohibition on Minors)

First Offense P 500.00 and one week suspension of permit
Second Offense P 1,000.00 and two weeks suspension of permit
Third Offense P 2,500.00 or imprisonment of not less than six
(6) months, or both, at the discretion of the
Court, without prejudice to the penalties imposed
for violation of existing national laws.

Section 23. Transitory Provision

All resolutions granting previous cockpit franchises shall remain valid and binding, provided that the owners, operators or licensee shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance in the ensuing year.

Section 24. Separability Clause

Should any Section or portion of this Ordinance be declared by any Court as unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of other Sections or provisions of this Ordinance and shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 25. Repealing Clause.

All other ordinances, rules and regulations that are in conflict or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 26. Effectivity Clause.
