AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 (2) OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 21, Series of 2018, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF GLORIA, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive requested to amend Section 3 (2) of the Municipal Ordinance No. 21, Series of 2018, entitled "An Ordinance Enacting the Revised Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the Municipal Government of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro for the creation of the Office of the Municipal Administrator;

WHEREAS, in Section 3 (2) of the Municipal Ordinance No. 21, Series of 2018, Municipal Administrator's Office is categorically classified as one department in the Local Government of Gloria, Province of Oriental Mindoro. Likewise, Section 13 of CSC MC No. 19, S. 1992, stipulates that a department is the highest structural unit/level composed of at least four divisions headed by an employee with a rank of Department Head;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Administrator (SG-24) is already included in the Plantilla of the Local Government Unit of Gloria under the Office of the Municipal Mayor since 2017 and will be separated as one department beginning 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Lauro L. De Belen jointly seconded by all members present during the session,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF GLORIA IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. Title

This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Amending Section 3 (2) of the Municipal Ordinance No. 21, Series of 2018, entitled "An ordinance Enacting the Revised Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the Municipal Government of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro

Section 2. Purpose

To meet the needs of the present demand of a very functional and responsive government institution of this Municipality, it is imperative for an amendment of the organizational structure and staffing pattern of the Municipal Government of Gloria.

Section 3. Amendment. SECTION 3 (2) of the Municipal Ordinance No. 21, Series of 2018, entitled "An ordinance Enacting the Revised Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the Municipal Government of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro is hereby amended by transferring the following funded positions under the Office of the Municipal Mayor to the Office of the Municipal Administrator as one department to wit:

OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR

1. Municipal Administrator (SG-24) Coterminous
2. Security Officer I (SG-11) Coterminous
3. Security Agent I (SG-8)
4. Administrative Aide IV (Storekeeper I) SG-4
5. Administrative Aide III (Utility Worker II) SG-3
6. Administrative Aide III (Utility Worker II) SG-3
7. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
8. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
9. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
10. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
11. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1

Section 4. Transfer of General Services Section. The General Services Section from the Office of the Municipal Mayor shall be transferred in the Office of the Municipal Administrator as one of its section.


Section 5. Separability Clause. In the event that a provision of this ordinance is found or decreed to be invalid or unconstitutional all other provisions hereof not affected by such pronouncement or decree remain to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


Section 7. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days from the date a copy thereof is posted on a bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall, as the case may be, and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality.





WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Gloria, Oriental Mindoro, submitted Municipal Ordinance No. 20, Series of 2019 of the Municipality of Gloria, entitled “An ordinance amending Section 3(2) of the Municipal Ordinance No. 21, Series of 2018, entitled “An ordinance enacting the Revised Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the Municipal Government of Gloria, Province of Oriental Mindoro”;


WHEREAS, the Committee on Human Resource Development, Labor, Employment, and Overseas Filipino Workers’ (OFWs) Welfare reviewed and studied said Ordinance and found out that the same was enacted pursuant to Section 447 of Local Government Code (“LGC of 1991”);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds Municipal Ordinance No. 20, series of 2019 to be within the conferred powers of the Sangguniang Bayan of Gloria to enact or approve under LGC of 1991, subject to full and continuing compliance of all relevant and applicable laws, rules and regulations, which shall be the full and primary responsibility of the LGU, Municipal Mayor and all concerned officials and employees of Gloria in the implementation of the said ordinance.



FOR: THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN

Dear Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan:

On 28 October 2019, Municipal Ordinance No. 20 S. 2019 of the Municipality of Gloria was referred to the Committee on Human Resource Development, Labor, Employment, and Overseas Filipino Worker's (OFWs) Welfare for review and appropriate action of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

Upon careful review of the provisions of said Ordinance, the Committee respectfully submits the hereinafter findings and recommendations.

LEGAL BASIS OF THE REVIEW:

Section 468 of the Local Government Code of 1991 grants power to the sangguniang panlalawigan, as the legislative body of the province to:

"(1) Approve ordinances and pass resolutions necessary for an efficient and effective provincial government and, in this connection, shall:

(i) Review all ordinances approved by the sanggunians of component cities and municipalities xx xx xx to determine whether these are within the scope of the prescribed powers of the sanggunian xx xx xx.”

FINDINGS OF THE COMMITTEE:

1. That, the Sangguniang Bayan of Gloria passed Municipal Ordinance No. 20 Series of 2019 to amend Section 3(2) of Municipal Ordinance No. 21 Series 2018 by transferring the following funded positions under the Office of the Municipal Mayor to the Office of the Municipal Administrator as one department, to wit:

OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATOR
1. Municipal Administrator (SG-24) Coterminous
2. Security Officer I (SG-11) Coterminous
3. Security Agent I (SG-8)
4. Administrative Aide IV (Storekeeper I) SG-4
5. Administrative Aide III (Utility Worker II) SG-3
6. Administrative Aide III (Utility Worker II) SG-3
7. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
8. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
9. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
10. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1
11. Administrative Aide I (Utility Worker I) SG-1

2. That, the subject Ordinance is within the scope of the prescribed powers of the Sangguniang Bayan to enact.

Based on **Section 3(b) of Republic Act No. 7160**, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (Code) of 1991:

“The formulation and implementation of policies and measures on local autonomy shall be guided by the following operative principles:

xx xx xx

(b) There shall be established in every local government unit an accountable, efficient, and dynamic organizational structure and operating mechanism that will meet the priority needs and service requirements of its communities;”

Significantly, **Section 76 of the Code** provides that:

“Every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission.”


3. That, while the Sangguniang Bayan is empowered to pass the subject Ordinance, all existing and applicable laws, rules and regulations shall be


complied with by the local government unit concerned in the implementation of the subject ordinance.

4. That, the subject Ordinance shall take effect after the Sangguniang Bayan has complied with the requirement of posting pursuant to the Code.

RECOMMENDATION:

Above premises considered, the Committee respectfully recommends before this Honorable Body to pass and approve a **RESOLUTION DECLARING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 20 S. 2019 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GLORIA, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(2) OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 21 SERIES OF 2018, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE AND STAFFING PATTERN OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF GLORIA, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO"** to be within the prescribed powers of the Sangguniang Bayan to enact, subject to full and continuous compliance by the local government unit concerned with all related laws, rules and regulations.
